

#### Written Communication Contest

The written communication contest is open to all 4-H members. The categories included are:

- Songwriting
- Poetry (3 line minimum and 25 line maximum)
- "What 4-H Means to Me" Essay (minimum 500 words)
- Original Monologue
- Press Release (maximum of 1,000 words)
- Public Service Announcement

#### Some rules to follow are:

- Each writing piece must be original. If there is a question, the participant will be disqualified. A statement of authenticity must be completed and attached to entry.
- All entries are to be on 8" x 11" paper, with the entrant's class, name, and county on a cover page and last name typed on every page. (See sample cover page). Please include scoring guide, and statement of authenticity at the back of the piece. Entries are to be double-spaced, typed with Calibri size 12 font white paper. (Songs may be single spaced within verses, chorus and bridge and double spaced between each of these.) For more information on how to write Songwriting, Poetry, Press Release, Public Service, and Monologue contact Annette. Also, you will need to contact Annette to get a copy of the cover letter, scoresheet, and statement of authenticity that will need to be submitted with your materials. All entries must be submitted by Wednesday, February 21st. If you have any questions, please contact Annette at the extension office.

### Pointers for giving a speech.

- Select a subject that interests you.
- Investigate and gather necessary materials on your topic.
- Organize the material into an outline containing an introduction, body and conclusion.
- Write your talk word for word so you know exactly what your are going to say.
- Remember the following: <u>Rate</u> how fast or slow you talk. <u>Intensity</u> how loud or soft you speak. <u>Fluency</u> talk smoothly. <u>Voice Expression</u> how you express your voice. <u>Movement</u> move only when it helps you talk.. Gestures how you use your hands when speaking. <u>Facial expressions</u> facial expressions should reflect what you are saying in your speech. <u>Eye</u> <u>Contact</u> look at your audience. Do not look at the floor or ceiling.
- Practice, Practice, Practice your speech!










### Vegetarian Taco Soup



- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 large onion, diced
- 1 can (46 ounces) no-saltadded tomato juice
- 2 cans (15 ounces) pinto beans, drained and rinsed
- 1 can (15 ounces) black beans, drained and rinsed
- 1 can (15 ounces) no-saltadded corn, drained
- 1 can (15 ounces) no-saltadded diced tomatoes
- 3/4 cup dry brown rice
- 1 packet reduced-sodium taco seasoning mix
- 2 tablespoons garlic powder
- 1/2 tablespoon cumin
- 4 cups water

**Optional toppings:** cilantro, cheese, diced onion, crushed tortilla chips, sour cream, jalapeno, hot sauce, or avocado.

- **1.** Wash hands with warm water and soap, scrubbing for at least 20 seconds.
- **2.** Heat olive oil in a large pot on the stovetop over medium heat.
- 3. Add diced onion and stir well.
- **4.** Cook and stir for 4 to 5 minutes or until the onion starts to turn clear.
- **5.** Add remaining ingredients and bring to a boil.
- **6.** Reduce heat to low. Cover and simmer for 40 minutes, or until rice is tender.
- 7. Just as you would a taco, top each bowl of soup with ingredients like cilantro, cheese, diced onion, crushed tortilla chips, sour cream, jalapeno, hot sauce, or avocado.
- **8.** Refrigerate leftovers within 2 hours.


